The Ålandstrafiken-ferries travel between Finland and Åland, and are free for cyclists, hikers and kayakers. In Sweden the Archipelago Route consists of the coastal and archipelago areas of Roslagen north of Stockholm, where numerous shipping companies co-operate to offer good connections between the islands.
